All participants in order to enter the contest must be a parent or guardian of the children creating the art.

TO ENTER: Between December 15, 2022 and January 31, 2023 (Extended from original January 15th date), families with children between the ages of 3-12, can enter the contest by having their children draw their piece of art imagining a mascot for NetCost Market®, giving the mascot a name and writing a short paragraph about the mascot's character, abilities and qualities. Contest submissions will be judged and awarded by age groups divided by ages 3-7 and 8-12. Each artist/contestant will be asked to draw their piece of art on an 8.5" x 11" or 11" X 17" sized drawing pad page (Letter or Tabloid Size) and write the mascot's name and description on the front-side bottom of that artwork. The little children can get an adult's help with writing only. The original artwork should be created by children. The creation of their art will be judged on creativity, originality and uniqueness. The contestants will be encouraged to use their imaginations in their creation. The mascot can be illustrated as any real or misterious creature, animal, person, flower, food or anything else that they can conceive of to create their art. Once completed, all the creations need to be brought to any NetCost Market Store on or before January 31st, 2023 (Extended from original January 15th date) for contest entry and display and deposit them in the specially created "NetCost Mascot" drawing and painting contest entry boxes located in each of the stores.
